**Jackson Mine Park IOHT Pavilion – Update**

The City will be submitting required documents along with a resolution from the City council accepting the \$291,000 MDNR Trust fund grant with the City's match being \$194,100. The total cost of the project equally \$485,100. When the State returns the signed agreement the project can officially move forward.

**Jackson Park Tennis Courts**

City staff updated the board on the Jackson Park tennis courts being sold, leased or donated to the Negaunee Public Schools. At the day of the meeting no final determination had been made on how the transfer was going to happen. Following a discussion a motion by Corkin and second by Thomas to include the property from the tennis courts east to the City property line including the east driveway entrance. Motion passed.

City staff is working on the current financials of the NBC. Staff will be giving the NBC a financial revenue/expenditure breakdown.

**NHS Softball/Negaunee Little League**
